Easton's legacy as an epicenter for local food dates to 1752 with the founding of the Easton Farmers' Market (Saturdays, eastonfarmersmarket.com), the nation's oldest continually operating open-air market.



The indoor Easton Public Market (Wednesday-Sunday, eastonpublicmarket.com) offers 14 artisan vendors offering up tacos, BBQ, ramen, pizzas, baked goods, chocolates, beverages and foodie-quality items like produce, meats, fresh fish, dairy, and much more. The West Ward Market (Wednesdays through September, westwardmarket.com) is a true neighborhood market west of downtown with fresh, local foods and community activities.



Over 30 diverse restaurants in the downtown area and another 40 citywide offer everything from fine dining to casual eats to authentic international cuisine. You won't go thirsty either: six craft breweries, a winery, and two distilleries – plus a half dozen independent coffeehouses – also call Easton home. (shopdowntowneaston.com)

Live at the Falls (Thursday evenings through September, liveatfalls.com) presents fabulous free musical performances along the Delaware. Monthly Fourth Friday events (eastonoutloud.com) feature live music and shopping fun throughout downtown.



The holidays come alive at Easton Winter Village (Friday-Sunday, November 18-December 17, eastonwintervillage.com), Over 40 outdoor shopping spots, entertainment, a skating rink and more share the glow of Easton's 106-foot Peace Candle and thousands of twinkling lights in Centre Square.
